Back of Aisle Decor and Signage: Meadow arrangements on both sides (3 large meadows/side; 6 total)

- To be repurposed: throughout ballroom and bar area
- In front of head table, with seating chart at ballroom entrance

First 2 rows reserved:

- 1st row: family
- 2nd row: wedding party

Welcome Table (back of ceremony as people walk up):

- Linen: Minikahda white linen w/ lace overaly (laelle provide)

- Guest book sign

- Card/gift sign in 8x10 frame

String Quartet: Front right of ceremony set-up/alter

- Equipment needed from Minikahda: 4 white chairs
- 2 overhead white umbrellas (The Cutting Garden) + 2 bases (The Cutting Garden)

Refreshment Station/Pre-Ceremony Cocktail: Back left of ceremony, towards clubhouse

- Glasses of sparkling wine passed by waitstaff as people walk up
- Equipment needed from Minikahda: Water dispenser on high top table w/ fruit-infused water, glasses, white minikahda linen
- Custom serving linen napkins for waitstaff (Laelle)
- White Umbrella (The Cutting Garden)

DJ: Back of ceremony, left of welcome station

- Equipment needed from Minikahda: high top table x1 w/ white linen
- DJ to provide ceremony audio (mic, micstand, etc)

Welcome Area - Entrance of Ballroom inside

To be moved from outside ceremony to inside at the entrance of ballroom doors - put on half round wood table outside ballroom

- Welcome Sign with floor arrangement
- Card Box
- Card/gift sign
- Seating Chart: Framed on easel w/ 1-2 meadows in front

Bar Area/Room (reception):

Ice Sculpture/Luge Station: In front of column in middle of room (see layout)
